

NEW RULES TO ENTER HUNGARY

You can travel to Hungary without restriction, regardless of your nationality *provided you:*

- a) can prove your immunity against the coronavirus by presenting an **official immunity certificate** issued in Hungary, or in a country that Hungary signed an agreement with on the mutual or unilateral recognition of protection certificates (besides the European and OECD countries, as well as the NATO members, and countries like: *China, Turkey, The United Arab Emirates, The Russian Federation, Kazakhstan, Bahrein, Japan, Israel.*) or
- b) can show an **EU digital Covid certificate** proving that
 - you have been vaccinated *at least once* with a vaccine authorised by the European Medicines Agency or Hungary, and *one year has not elapsed* since the first vaccination, or
 - you have *had a Covid infection within the past 6 month*, or
- c) can present a document in Hungarian or English language containing the result of a **SARS-CoV-2 PCR test**, taken in the countries listed in point a), **not more than 72 hours old**, certifying that the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus was not detectable in your body at the time of the test

The **police authority** may also authorise entry if the applicant proves that the purpose of entry is to fulfil an obligation to study or take examinations on the basis of a student or pupil status, if this is attested by a certificate issued by the educational institution

Admitted university/college students who don't meet the above requirements can enter the country with the authority of the police, and on condition that they can prove their admitted status with a certificate issued by the school. In this case the students have to stay in a **quarantine for 10 days** after arrival in Hungary.

NB: Before coming to WBS students need to inform the school about the date of their entry into the country!

Otherwise, non-Hungarian citizens are not allowed to enter the territory of Hungary for passenger transport!
